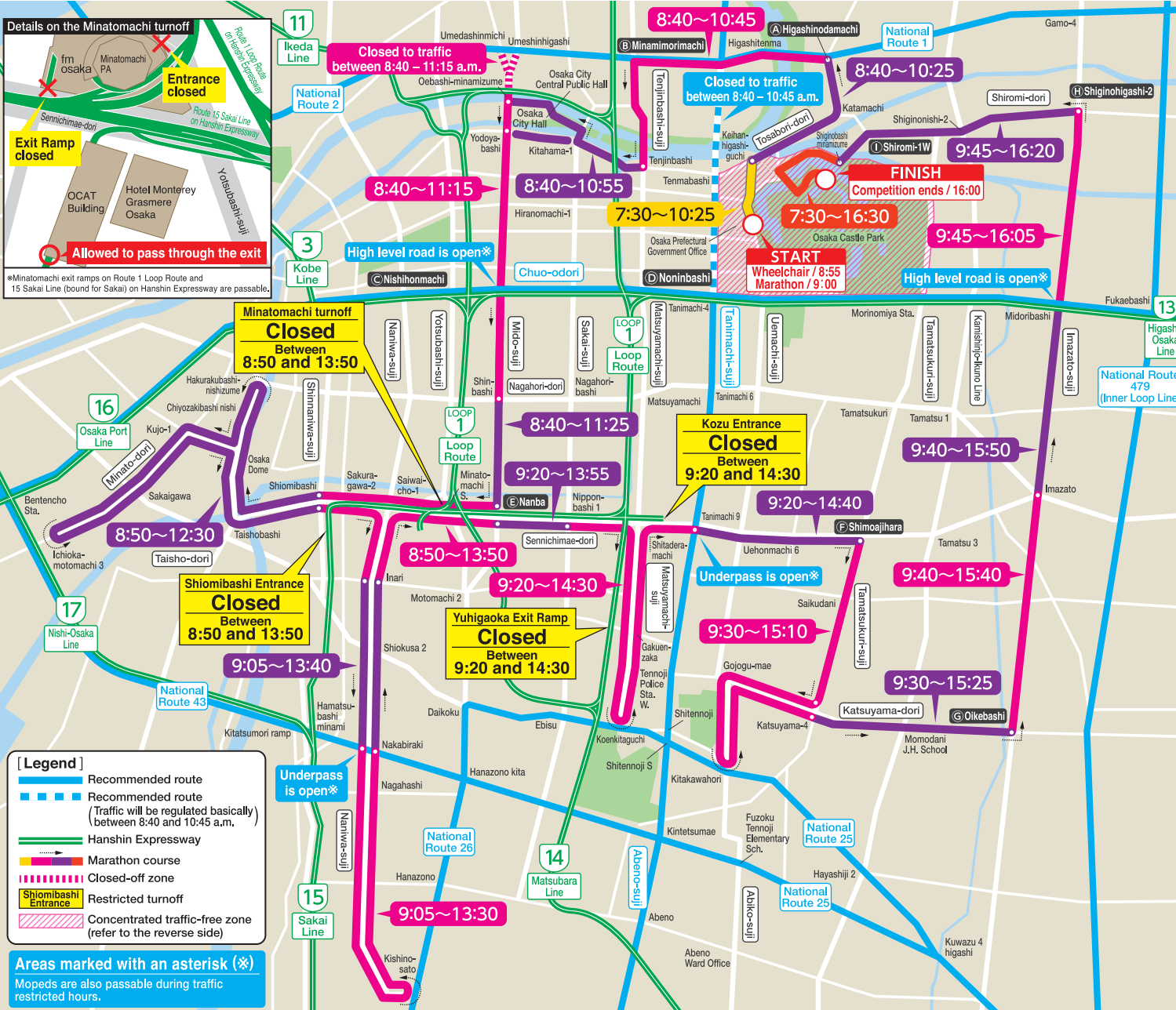


# The Osaka Marathon 2019 Traffic Regulation Information

7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

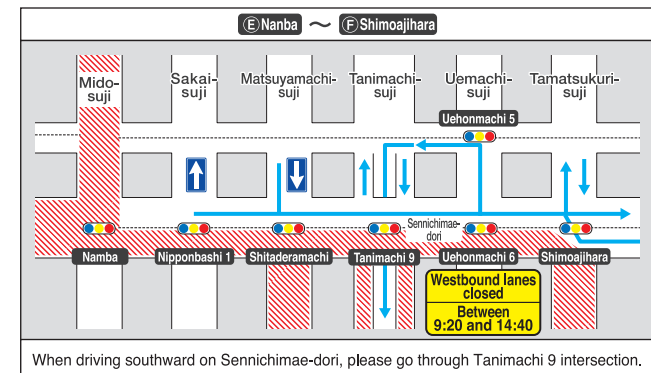
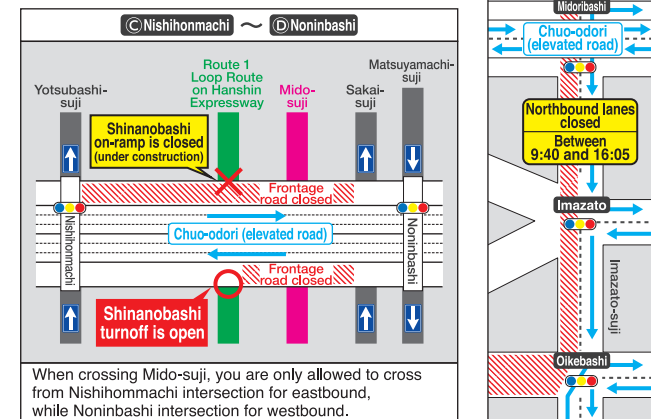
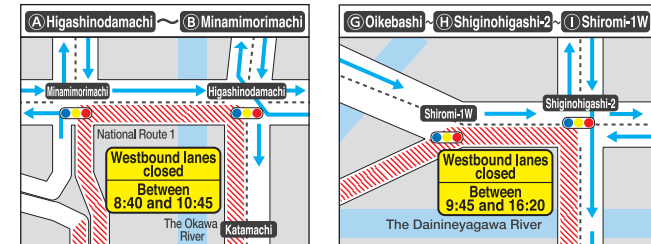


Stopping, standing and parking will all be prohibited within the marathon course.



During the traffic restrictions, passing and/or crossing the road is prohibited. Crossing the road on the marathon course for bicycles and pedestrians will also be restricted. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your understanding in advance.

### Detailed Map of Traffic Regulation



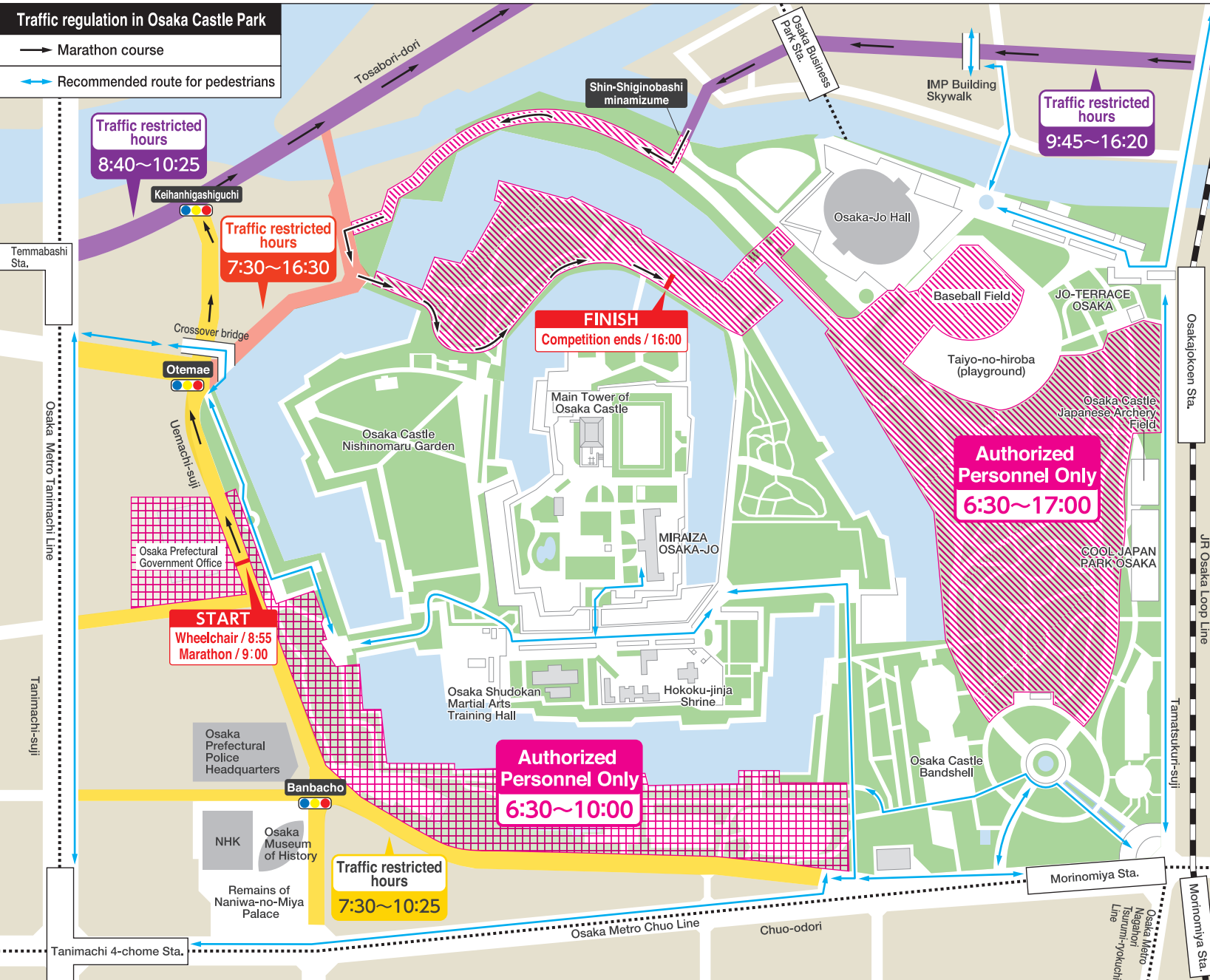

# The Osaka Marathon 2019 Traffic Regulation Information

## Sunday, December 1, 2019



The parking space in Osaka Castle Park is not available throughout the day.

We ask for your cooperation to conduct the event safely.

- Crossing the marathon course is prohibited during the traffic restriction hours.
- Passing through the road on the marathon course for bicycles and pedestrians will also be restricted. We ask pedestrians to use the overpass or pedestrian tunnel, etc.
- The marathon course and its nearby roads will be closed up to over eight hours.
- When driving a car, we advise you to take a recommended route, major open route or expressway.
